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




# **ABOUT US**

# BACKGROUND

Uganda has the youngest population in the world, with 78 Percent of its population being under 30 years of age representing significant development potential. But if left untapped, it could turn into a major development challenge. Uganda's national unemployment rate is 9.2%, while the unemployment rate for youth aged 18-30 is 13.3%

Academic education and training as introduced by the British in Uganda had little inclination towards Skills development. The colonial government's education was designed to impart learners with purely academic (cognitive) skills; starving them of the more work-relevant or practical skills.

Although the government is refocusing its training on skills, it has reported negative attitude from the youth who think skills and business technical vocational education training (BTVET). is for the academically dull students.

At Purple Skills Klinic foundation, we have that charge of impacting everybody in the country to see that practical skilling is the way forward if we are to solve the youth unemployment challenge, create jobs and improve our economy. The National Skills Expo is an opportunity to change the negative attitude of youth towards practical skills training, by exhibiting services and products created by various skilled youth while using the platform to draw interest to careers around business technical vocational education training (BTVET) as a solution to youth unemployment and job creation.

Ahead of the Expo, over 6 training workshops skilling upto 200 youth each shall be organized at grassroot level and participants shall be given free skills training.

# 04- PITCH INNOVATIVE IDEAS FOR FUNDS

Participating youth shall pitch innovative ideas to potential funders and win seed capital to jumpstart their careers.



#### Format:

The <u>two-day event</u> will closely mirror the flow and appearance of a real fair. The fair will be open to all. It will have a number of parallel sessions focussed both thematic and sectoral.

Participants will have the opportunity to learn from experts, share their experiences with others, interact with participants from other countries and visit the exhibition hall where a number of booths will be set up by a selected set of institutions.
